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# Fence Contract

**WHEREAS**, the Client desires to have a fence installed on their property, and the Contractor represents that it has the necessary skills, experience, and resources to perform such work;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

## 1. Scope of Work

The Contractor shall supply all labor, materials, tools, and equipment necessary to design, construct, and install a fence at the Client's property located at

The work shall include, at a minimum:

- Site preparation and marking of fence boundaries
- Supply and installation of fencing materials
- Installation of posts, panels, gates, and hardware
- Cleanup and removal of debris upon completion

Any work not expressly included in this section shall be considered outside the scope and may require a written change order.

## 2. Contract Price and Payment Terms

## 3. Project Timeline

The Contractor shall promptly notify the Client of any delays caused by weather, material shortages, site conditions, or other circumstances beyond the Contractor’s control.

## 4. Permits and Approvals

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the Client shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits, approvals, and permissions required for the installation of the fence.

The Contractor shall reasonably cooperate by providing documentation or information required for such permits.

## **5. Site Conditions and Access**

The Client shall provide the Contractor with reasonable access to the property during normal working hours.

The Client is responsible for:

- Identifying property boundaries accurately
- Disclosing underground utilities, easements, or obstructions to the extent known

The Contractor shall not be responsible for damage caused by undisclosed or inaccurately identified underground conditions.

## **6. Changes to the Work**

Any modification to the scope, materials, design, or timeline must be documented in a written change order signed by both parties.

The change order shall specify any adjustments to the Contract Price and completion date.

## **7. Warranty**

The Contractor warrants that the work will be performed in a professional manner consistent with industry standards.

The Contractor further warrants that:

- Labor shall be free from defects for a period of \_\_\_\_\_

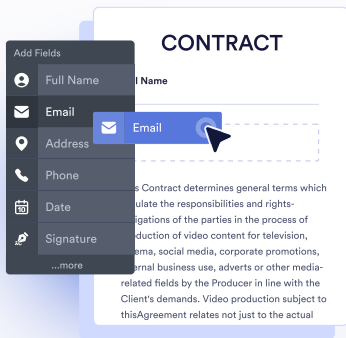


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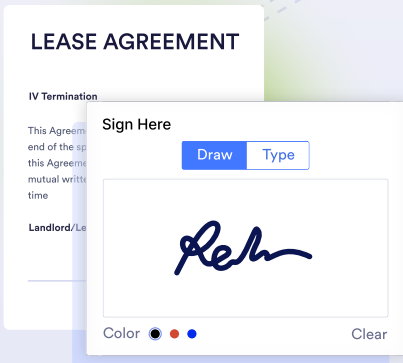
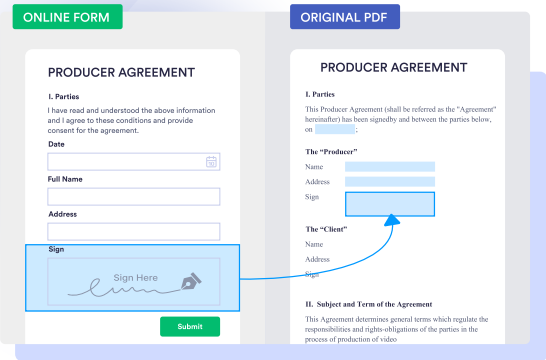
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
