1. Parties

This **Livestock Bill of Sale** has been signed by and between the Seller and the Buyer to arrange the sale of livestock which is described in this agreement. The Parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth below, and agree to execute this agreement as evidence of the sale of the livestock.

3. Price and Payment

The total price for the abovementioned livestock is _____. This amount includes transportation costs and the cost of any goods and equipment required during transportation.

As a down payment, _____% of the total amount shall be paid within 3 days of signing this agreement. If the Buyer fails to pay down payment, it will be deemed as the withdrawal of this agreement.

Balance payment shall be done at the date of delivery, after the Buyer completes the review procedure and signs the acceptance note.

4. Delivery

The Seller is responsible for delivering the livestock to the Buyer. The Seller accepts and undertakes that the livestock will be transferred with vehicles suitable for their healthy and physical conditions. The Seller is solely responsible for any damages and losses incurred during transportation including contagious diseases, destruction, death or whatsoever.

5. Warranty

Seller warrants that he is the legal owner of the livestock described in this agreement, and has the right to sell the livestock to the Buyer. The Seller also warrants that the livestock are raised in healthy conditions, veterinary examinations are made on time, necessary vaccinations are made, and that they are fed with first class quality food.

6. Inspection

The Buyer has the right to inspect the livestock upon delivery. If the Buyer determines that the livestock does not meet the determined criterias in this agreement as a result of the inspection, may refrain from taking delivery. This situation is immediately notified to the seller in writing. If the Buyer fails to inspect the livestock at the time of delivery, then the Buyer shall be deemed to have accepted the livestock in their current condition.

No payment will be made for the livestock that are not accepted as a result of the inspection.

7. Governing Law

Any dispute arising in relation between this agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____ . Any legal action or proceeding arising under or related to this agreement shall be brought exclusively in the courts of _____ .

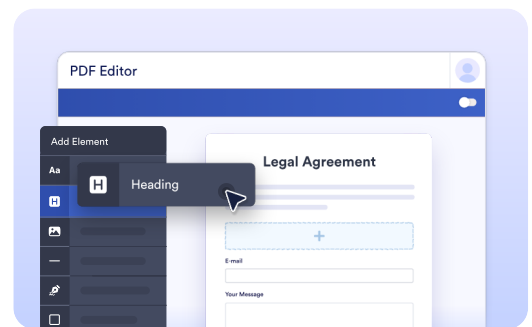

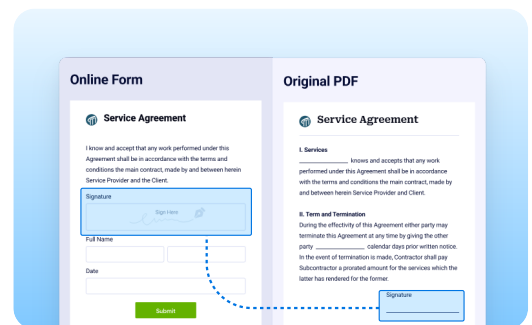

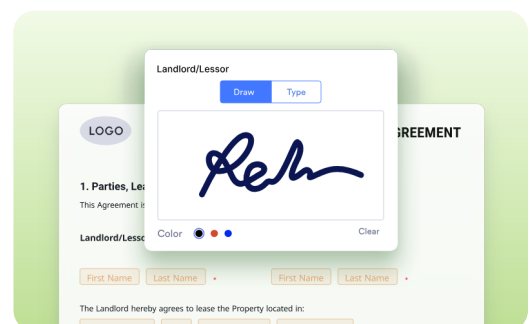
