## Terms and Conditions

**Parties.** This **School Vendor Contract** ("**Contract**") is made as of \_\_\_\_\_, by and between the School and the Vendor identified above, to determine the terms and conditions for the Vendor to provide goods and services to the School.

**Scope of Contract.** The Vendor agrees to provide the School with goods and/or services as described below (*If deemed necessary, an additional contract containing the details will be signed as an attachment to this Contract*);

**Term of Contract.** This Contract shall commence on the date of signature and continue for an initial term of \_\_\_\_\_ unless terminated earlier as provided in this Contract. The term may be renewed upon mutual written agreement of the Parties.

**Pricing and Payment Terms.** The School agrees to pay a total amount of \_\_\_\_\_ to the Vendor. \_\_\_\_\_% of the total amount shall be paid as an initial payment. Balance amount shall be paid in \_\_\_\_\_ equal installments. In case of late payment, \_\_\_\_\_% interest rate shall apply and the Vendor may suspend service provision.

**Vendor's Responsibilities.** The Vendor agrees to provide high-quality goods and/or services as described above. Vendor shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and school policies during service provision and maintain necessary licenses, certifications, and insurance. The Vendor shall report any issues or delays to the School immediately.

**School's Responsibilities.** The School agrees to make timely payments in accordance with the payment schedule set forth in this Contract. School shall provide access to facilities as necessary for the Vendor to perform its duties and provide necessary information and support required for the Vendor to fulfill the obligations arising from this Contract.

**Termination.** Either party may terminate this Contract for any reason by providing \_\_\_\_\_ written notice to the other party. In such a case, the School shall pay the Vendor for all Services rendered and expenses incurred up to the effective date of termination. Either party may terminate this Agreement immediately if the other party materially breaches any term of this Contract and fails to cure such breach within \_\_\_\_\_ of receiving written notice specifying the breach.

**Confidentiality.** The Vendor agrees to keep confidential any information regarding the School, its students, and staff obtained in connection with the performance of this Contract.

**Entire Agreement.** This Contract constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes any prior understandings, whether written or oral.

**Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of \_\_\_\_\_.

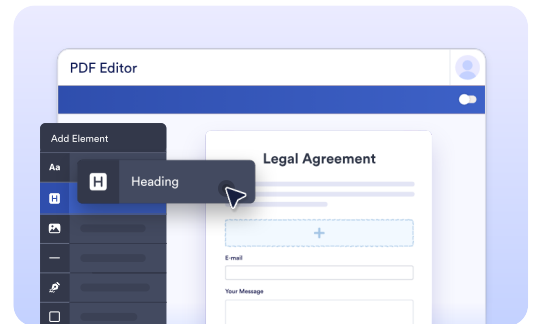

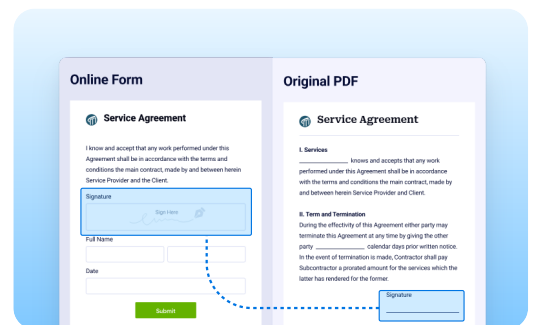

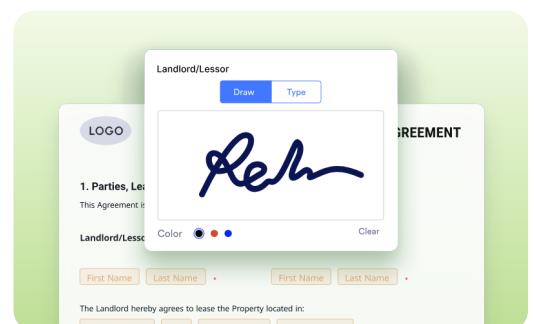
