## **Terms and Conditions**

- This Spay/Neuter Contract has been signed by and between the Veterinary Clinic and the Pet Owner indicated above, and The Owner wishes to have the pet spayed/neutered, and the Clinic agrees to perform the spay/neuter procedure subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract.
- The Clinic agrees to perform the spay/neuter procedure on the pet identified above. The procedure will be performed by qualified veterinary professionals who are authorized to animal surgery in accordance with the Code of Veterinary Practice.
- The Pet Owner acknowledges that spaying/neutering is a surgical procedure that carries inherent risks, and the Pet Owner assumes all risks associated with the procedure. The Clinic will take all necessary precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of the pet during the procedure.
- The Owner agrees to follow all pre-operative instructions provided by the Clinic, including but not limited to fasting requirements, restrictions on food and water intake, and any other preparatory measures deemed necessary by the Clinic.
- The Owner agrees to provide all necessary information about the pet's medical history, including any pre-existing conditions, allergies, medications, or other relevant information that may impact the spay/neuter procedure.

- The Owner assumes all risks associated with the procedure and releases the Clinic from any liability for complications arising from the procedure, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct by the Clinic.
- The Pet Owner agrees to pay the Clinic \_\_\_\_\_ for the spay/neuter procedure, which includes the cost of the surgery, anesthesia, medications, and any other related expenses. Payment for the spay/neuter procedure is due in full at the time of service unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties. The Owner acknowledges that payment is non-refundable, regardless of the outcome of the procedure.
- In the event that unforeseen complications arise during the spay/neuter procedure that require additional medical attention or treatment, the Owner agrees to be responsible for any additional costs incurred beyond the initial fee.
- The pet is kept under surveillance at the clinic for \_\_\_\_\_ hours following the surgical intervention and is delivered to the Pet Owner if the veterinarian gives approval. The Clinic will provide post-operative care instructions to the Owner, including information on wound care, medication administration, activity restrictions, and signs of complications. The Pet Owner agrees and undertakes to follow all post-operative care instructions provided by the Clinic.
