## Terms and Conditions

This **Student Safety Contract** (the "**Contract**" hereinafter) has been signed by and between the School and Parent to provide safe and secure environment for the students. This Contract outlines the general rules and expectations for student behavior while on school property, in laboratories, and during any school-related activities.

The Parent is responsible for ensuring that the Student is informed about the rules within the scope of the contract and complies with the rules.

## Laboratory Safety Rules

Students may only enter and work in the laboratory under the direct supervision of a teacher or authorized staff member. Students must wear the appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety goggles, gloves, and lab coats, as required by the teacher. Personal protective equipment must be worn at all times while conducting experiments or handling chemicals.

Students must handle all laboratory materials and equipment carefully and only as directed by the teacher. Unauthorized experiments or misuse of equipment are not allowed. Students must never taste, touch, or smell any chemicals unless specifically instructed to do so by the teacher.

Any accidents, spills, or broken equipment must be reported to the teacher immediately. Students should not attempt to clean up spills or handle broken equipment without instructions.

## Transportation Rules

Students must follow the bus driver's instructions and behave respectfully. Loud, disruptive behavior or distracting the driver is not allowed. Student must remain seated while the bus is in motion. They must keep aisles clear and remain in their assigned seats, if applicable.

Students must board and exit the bus in an orderly manner. Pushing or shoving is strictly prohibited. Students must keep their heads, arms, and hands inside the bus at all times and refrain from throwing objects inside or outside the bus.

## Internet Usage and Safety

Students must use school technology resources, including computers and the internet, responsibly and for educational purposes only. Accessing inappropriate content or engaging in cyberbullying is strictly prohibited.

The use of personal electronic devices during school hours is only permitted with teacher approval for educational activities. Devices must be turned off and stored away during classes unless otherwise instructed. Students must respect the privacy of others and not share personal information, passwords, or other sensitive data online or through school networks.

## Enforcement
